



E-LIFE: Kid-2-Kid Evangelism and Mentorship

Set the bar high by challenging kids to reach *their world* through E-LIFE and *the world* by praying and giving!

E-LIFE is one of the “GO” components of BGMC’s *Pray, Give, Go* challenge. BGMC challenges kids to reach ***their world*** through E-LIFE and ***the world*** by praying and giving.

Through E-LIFE, kids live out the “Five Commitments of an E-LIFE Kid” as missionaries to their schools and communities (listed below). In doing so, E-LIFE Kids *demonstrate* the love of Jesus.

- **Seek** the Holy Spirit’s help.
- **Show** kindness and friendship.
- **Share** the story of Jesus and your story of salvation (evangelism).
- **Invite** others to know Jesus and to church (evangelism).
- **Invest** in the lives of others (mentorship).

Leaders “coach” kids how to live out these five commitments through the following 5- to 10-minute activities:

- **E-xtreme Fun**—games
- **High Octane**—object lessons
- **Snap Shots**—Scripture pictures
- **Instant Replies**—illustrated Bible stories
- **Get Real**—group discussions



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The E-LIFE Plan

The Bible Scriptures should be recited often by kids, and they should be encouraged to memorize the Scripture passages.

Theme Verse: “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved (have Eternal Life)” (Romans 10:13).

The E-LIFE Plan of Salvation

Bible is an account the E-LIFE Kids should memorize and can use when addressing to another kid—in the context referred to as sharing “The Story.” Help the E-LIFE Kids memorize the Scripture verses and rehearse the E-LIFE Plan application often so they can share the plan of salvation with other kids.

E—Eternal life given through Jesus (Gift stands for heaven, our eternal reward)

John 2:16
“I did not come to the world that he gives his son and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life (E-LIFE).”

L—Life eternal as a gift from God (Gift stands for life)

John 3:16
“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life (E-LIFE).”

I—If we confess, he will forgive (Gift stands for mercy, which is Jesus in us)

1 John 1:9
“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us.”

F—Forgiveness is free (Gift stands for Jesus’ blood, shed to forgive our sins)

John 1:12
“Whoever believes on him receives forgiveness.”

E—Everyone can join God’s family (Gift stands for heaven, our eternal reward)

1 Peter 3:7
“Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

E-LIFE 3-D Discoveries

Making Right Choices
STUDENT HANDOUT #6

In previous Discoveries, we’ve talked about listening to God and following His road map, the Bible. When you do these things, you will begin to know what God wants you to do. But sometimes you’ll run into sticky situations where you will be faced with a choice. What can you do then?

One thing you can do is ask yourself this question: What does the Bible say about this? Or ask yourself: What would Jesus want me to do?

Focus Your Attention

E-LIFE E-Journal

This is an optional activity that can assist leaders in tracking the progress of the E-LIFE Kids. Print one journal for each student each month. Fill in the student’s name and the name of the month on the spaces provided. Read to each E-LIFE Commitment below, in the column called “Tally.” Have the student mark the number of times he/she fulfilled that commitment during the month. A mark could be a tally or a check mark, or the date could be written. Place as many marks, tallies, or dates as necessary. In the “Coach’s Signoff” column, you or the coach should write your initials showing that you have met individually with the student to discuss his/her fulfillment of the E-LIFE Commitment.

It is suggested that you keep the student’s file in a three-ring binder to track the progress of all the E-LIFE Kids whom you coach. At the end of the year, recognize all the E-LIFE Kids for their outstanding accomplishments.
