

Holding a BGMC–Master’s Toolbox Garage Sale



A BGMC–Master’s Toolbox Neighborhood Garage Sale for Missions is designed to get the families in your church (and their neighbors) to contribute used items for sale so that the money raised will go to missions. Imagine getting 40 neighbors to each donate \$25 worth of used items. That would equal \$1000 raised for missions!

Each participant should be given several copies of the flyer. A boy in each family fills out the blanks on the flyer that show when and where neighbors can deliver donated items for the garage sale.

The boys, along with their parents, then hand out the completed flyers in their neighborhoods. They can also give flyers to extended family members and friends. Pass them out to anyone who may want to donate items.

We suggest that items be brought to the home on Friday and then sold on Saturday. We also suggest that different families in the church have their garage sales on different Saturdays. Leftovers from one garage sale can then be donated to the next family’s garage sale on a following Saturday.

Boys should always make sure to get their parents’ permission before beginning a project like this.
