## NSSP Age Groups

Competitive shooting events will be held in the following age categories.

Sub Junior (age 9-10)

Intermediate Junior (age 11-13)

Junior (age 14-15)

Senior (age 16-17)

\*\* Adult (age 18 and up)

Age of competition is determined by the age you will be when competing in the event,

\*\* Adult participation in the NSSP events will be limited to **Trap Open, Archery Open & Competition**, and **Muzzleloader Open & Competition**. **BB Gun, .177 Sporter Air Rifle**, and **.22 Rifle** events will be reserved for boys only.

## Camp Rules Concerning Firearms & Ammunition

The ONLY firearms permitted on-site/in camp:

- Muzzleloader rifles (intended for competition or approved by FCF for display in the encampment)
  - Daisy model #499 BB gun (intended for competition)
  - Any .177 cal Sporter air rifle (intended for competition)
1. All outposts and/or individuals will be required to check in **ALL** firearms at the appropriate location and time as described in the match guidelines for safety inspection.
  2. Only firearms that pass a safety inspection may be used to participate in a NSSP competition.
  3. Any outpost participating in a shooting competition and transporting any firearms for this reason must keep these firearms in a case that can be locked. These firearms should only be accessible for the competition and not outside the storage case or handled anywhere but at the range. Any firearm seen handled in campsites or transported improperly will be confiscated by security and held in safekeeping until that outpost/individual checks out to return home.
  4. The only exception will be the FCF encampment where display of unloaded black powder rifles is allowed per safety guidelines.
  5. **NO AMMUNITION** will be allowed onsite. Camp Staff will provide and store ammunition for each NSSP events. **Exception:** FCF black powder rifle ammunition and powder (Note: FF& FFF black powder will be available at the Brownells Range for any competitor if needed for that competition.)

### **SAFETY FIRST AT ALL TIMES!**

- Safety is the number one concern of all Match Officials, Range Staff, coaches, adult leaders, and competitors!
- Proper safety procedures will be enforced at all times. During all NSSP events, safety infractions will be noted, and **ONE WARNING** will be issued to the shooter and the coach/parent/commander/adult leader. A second infraction will result in the immediate removal and disqualification of the shooter from “Open” or “Competition” events.
- If the infraction occurs during team competition and more than one member of the same team violates safety procedures, the entire team will be disqualified and removed from competition.
- Proper eye protection (and ear protection where noted) will be required for all persons from the ready line and forward to the target area.

How do I register for the competitive shooting events at Camporama?

All individuals who wish to compete in BB-Gun, Air Rifle, Archery, or Blackpowder Rifle should read the rules/guidelines document for each event. These documents will clarify any restrictions, categories, dates/times, equipment, fees, and other important information. Note that some events are on the same day and times. For example BB-Gun team and individual Air rifle are at the same day/time. You should choose one of these events. There will be specific times where events are “open,” to everyone and no additional fees are required. Those days/times are listed in this document.

The Individual Registration Form is used for the following competitive shooting events.

- Archery
- BB-Gun
- Sporter Air Rifle
- Black Powder Rifle

You do not need a separate form for each event. One form can be used to register an individual for more than one event.

Adult men can compete in Archery and/or Black Powder Rifle; other events are boys only.

All boys competing in the BB-Gun team event will need to register using the individual form. The BB-Gun team form is needed so we will know who the individual members are. Each team must have five members competing. There are no four man or six man teams. Team results are derived from the five individual scores.

Each BB-gun team will need to submit:

- 5 individual registration forms
- 1 BB-Gun Reporting Form
- Payment of check or cc for entry fees

Archery, Sporter Air Rifle, and Black Powder Rifle are individual events.

When sending in registration forms that include credit card information it is recommended you fax or mail forms. **Do not send cc information via email.**
